

The process is completely in-house, from inspiration to creation and production, so Ultimo comes with exclusive designs that you can't find anywhere else. By adding a bevel on the edges, it enjoys a more authentic natural look. What's more, we use a large pattern and cut out planks and tiles cleverly to avoid obvious repeats. This gives Ultimo a look that's closer to nature.

A sustainable backing layer with extra grip





Connecting Ultimo to the prepared subfloor beneath, the backing layer has an important part to play. We've added an embossed 'grip' texture to give the adhesive extra hold. There's also a direction arrow, so you know exactly which way to lay your plank and tile to create an authentic looking floor. This layer features up to 70% recycled content, another way we're reducing Ultimo's impact on the planet.
